The conference seeks to explore the relevance of Kant's philosophy in addressing the ethical challenges posed by the current ecological crisis, the moral standing of non-human animals, and the question of vulnerability. We welcome submissions from all scholars working in Kantian ethics, Environmental Ethics, Vulnerability, Aesthetics, and Animal Ethics, strongly encouraging submissions from early-career researchers, MPhil and PhD students.

To submit an abstract, please send an email to lkggc2023@gmail.com with two documents. The first document should contain a title and an abstract in English (no more than 500 words) prepared for blind review. The second document should include a brief biographical note (no more than 250 words).

Deadline for submission: June 1st, 2023.

Notice of acceptance: June 15th, 2023.

If you wish to give a talk in a language other than English, an english version of the paper must be provided upon acceptance, to be projected during the presentation.
